Camper Dress Code

- Campers must be dressed for “active” participation.
- Shorts should be of a reasonable length; “short” shorts will not be allowed.
- Campers must wear clothing that completely covers the torso. Shirts must have sleeves or armholes; halter, strapless, and backless tops may not be worn.
- Apparel having biased, offensive or profane messages will not be permitted. Items depicting or implying racial hatred, stereotyping, or prejudice will not be tolerated.
- **Sneakers (closed toe shoes) must be worn.**
- **NO sandals or flip flops.**
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Camp Dismissal

- Your child will be allowed to walk home ONLY if “Walk Home” is marked on the registration form.
- You must come into the auditorium to pick your child up and sign him/her out.
- Campers will be dismissed ONLY to persons on the camper’s registration form.
- Unless it is an extreme emergency, we ask that your child not be picked up early.

Items not to Bring to Camp

- Electronic Devices (iPods, mp3 players, game devices)
- Toys and other personal items need to remain at home.
- **Cell phones are permitted, but they can only be used at the end of the day to call to check on a ride. Any other use of the phone will result in confiscation until the parent arrives.**
- Living Abundantly Ministries, Lubbock ISD, and the All-Star Sports Camp are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged items.

Visitors/Volunteer Policy

- Visitors are always welcome at the All-Star Sports Camp, however, **ALL** visitors are required to check in at the registration table.
- Persons visiting camp without proper identification or nametag will be asked to leave.

- All volunteers at the All-Star Sports Camp complete a volunteer application, undergo criminal background checks (age permitting) and attend a child-safety training.

Child Guidelines and Rules

Have fun and enjoy All-Star Sports Camp. Campers need to WALK inside the school building. Children must respect other campers and volunteers at all times. Children must wear shoes at all times. Cursing and profane language will not be tolerated. Do not bring toys, iPods, CDs, etc. to the All-Star Sports Camp.

Discipline
