

The God that Provides

Passage Genesis 22:1-14

Main verse: Verse 14, “So Abraham called that place the Lord Will Provide. And to this day, it is said, ‘On the mountain of the Lord it will be provided.’”

- I. Observations from the passage
 - a. What Abraham did: He answered God and he obeyed God
 - b. What Abraham did not do: He didn't question God nor did he tell anyone what God had called him to do.
 - c. Abraham spoke words of faith (Verses 4-8)

- II. Lessons for us from this passage.
 - a. We must love the provider more than the provision.
 - b. We have to wait upon the Lord to move in our lives.
 - c. We need to speak statements of faith into our situations.
 - d. We need to obey God and when He calls us to do something
 - e. As we begin to obey Him, we must look for His provision.
