Scripture: Matthew 4:18-22

Key Verses: 19 & 20 "Jesus said to them, "Follow Me. I will make you fish for men!" At once they left their nets and followed Him."

I. Jesus called Peter to be a disciple.

Definition of disciple: one who accepts and assists in spreading the doctrines of another. This means we need to be reading the Bible regularly and we can't pick and choose which doctrines we accept.
